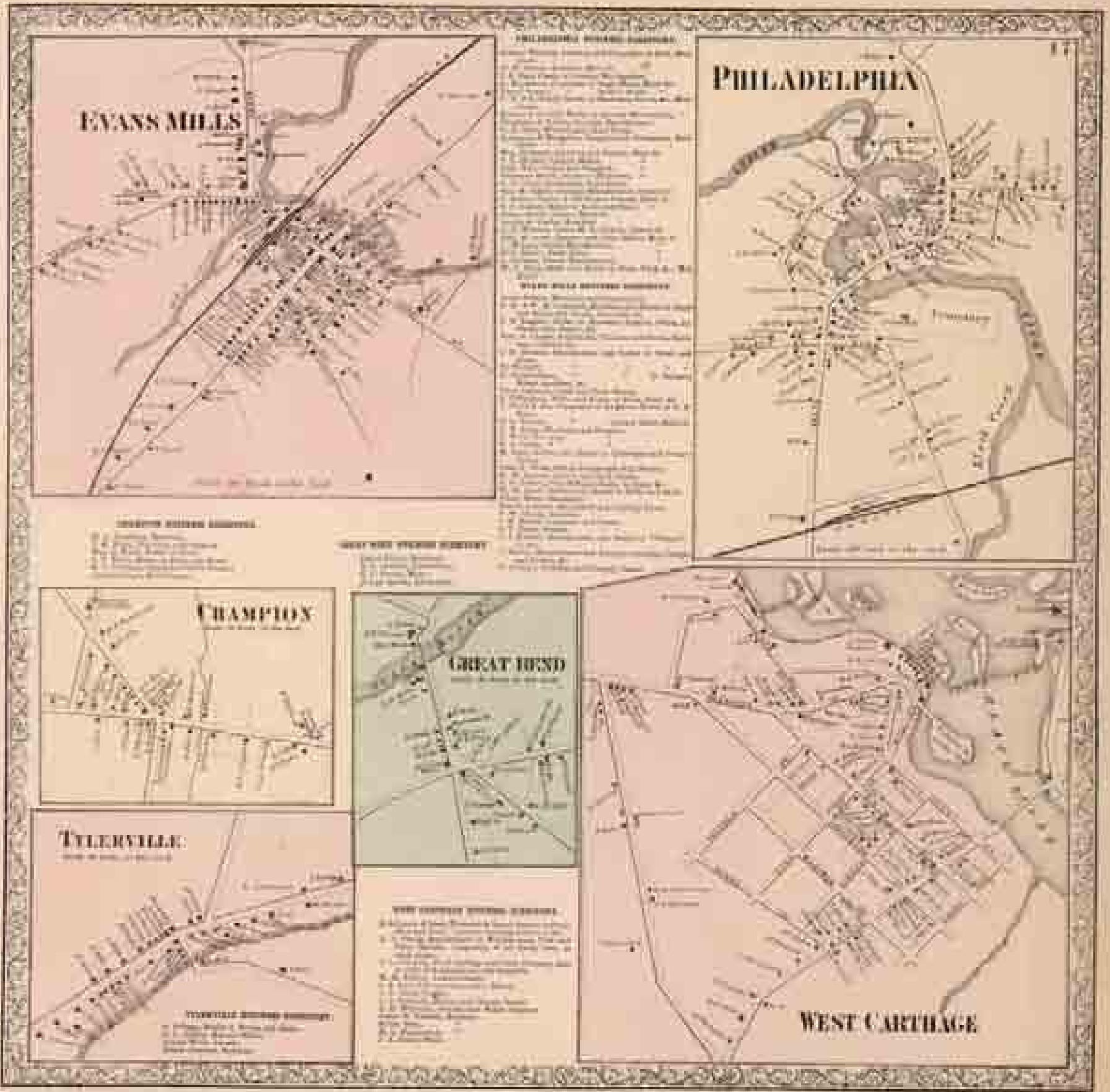
Map of Wramville in the year 1864.

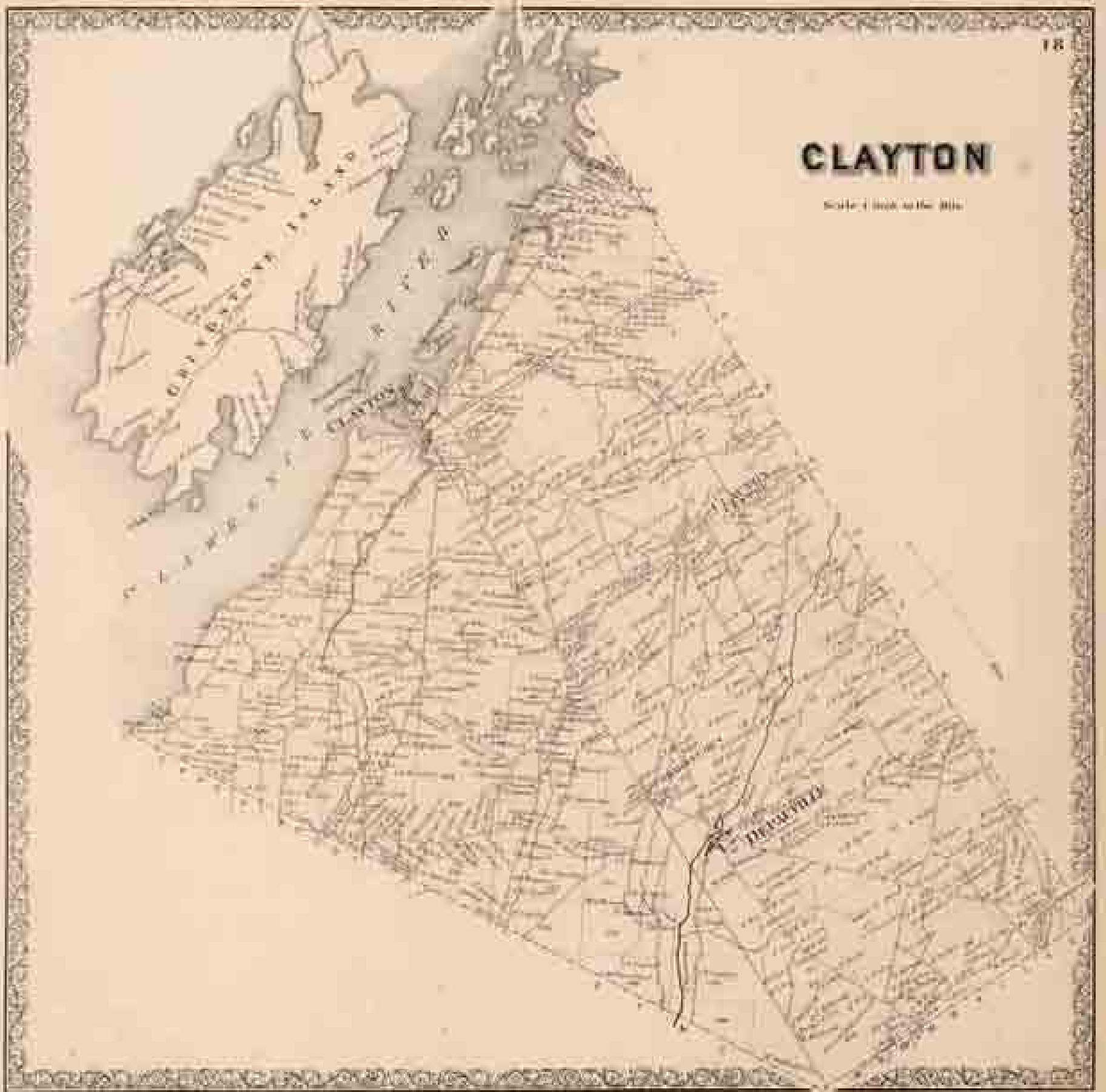






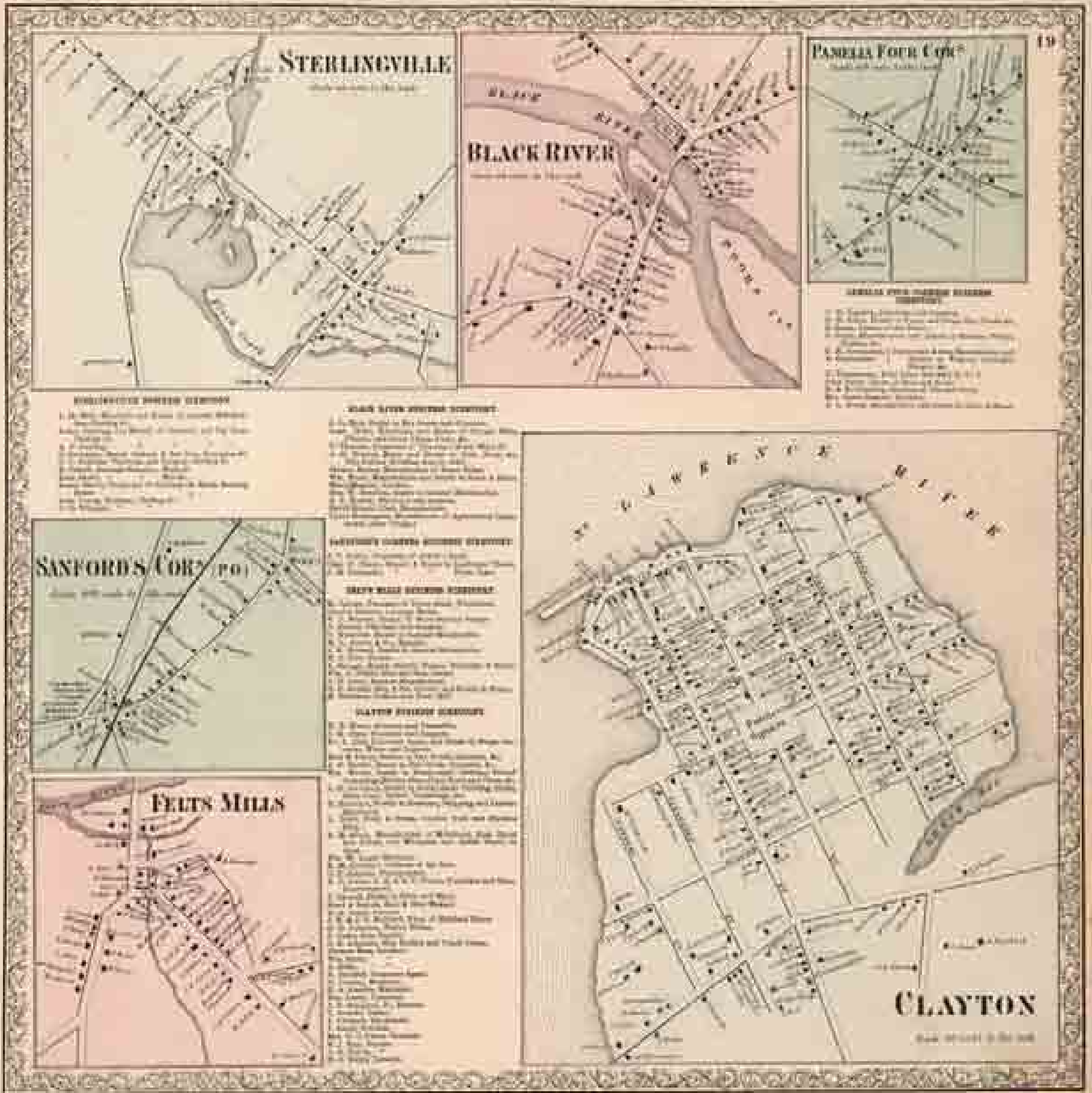






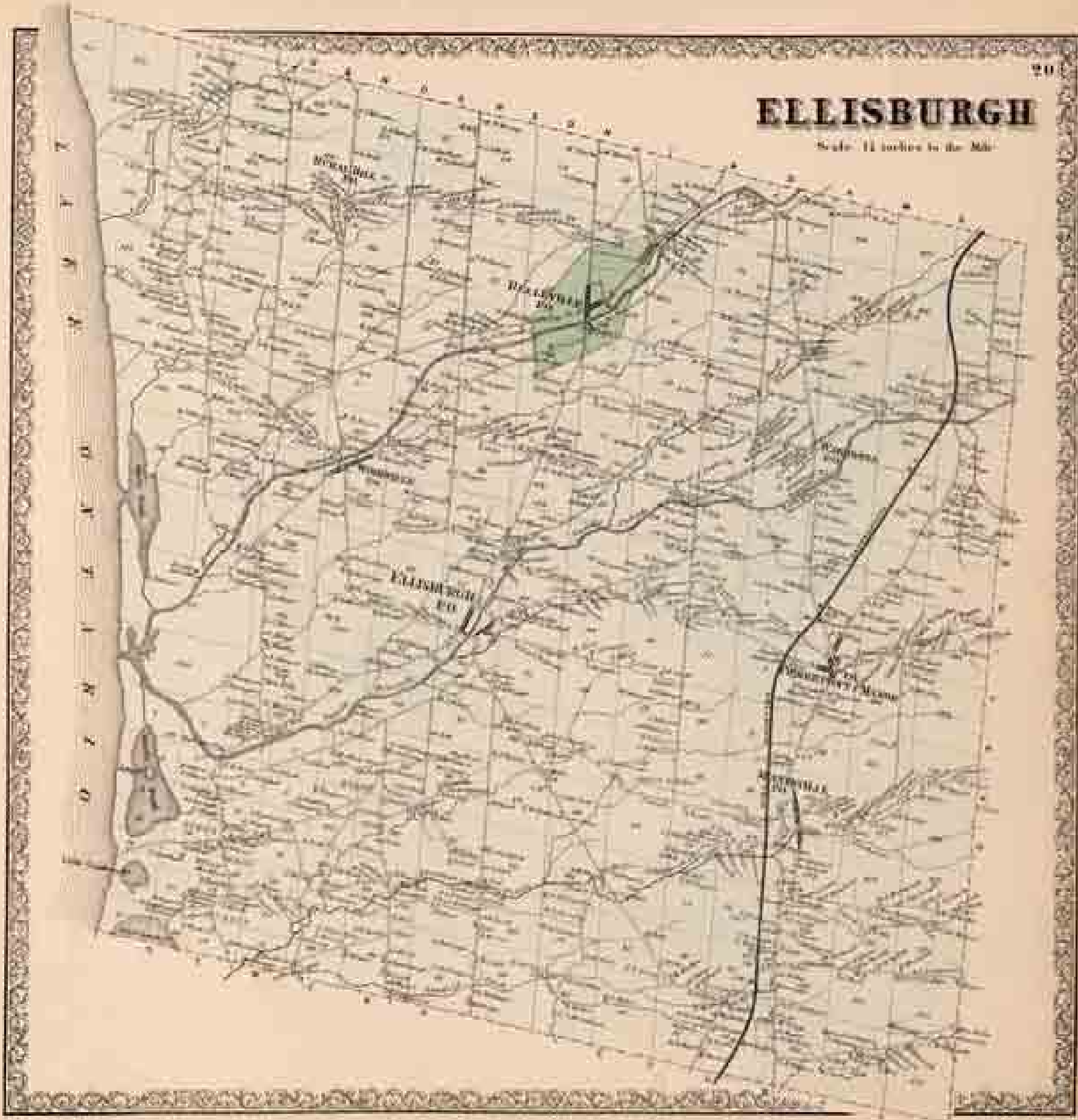

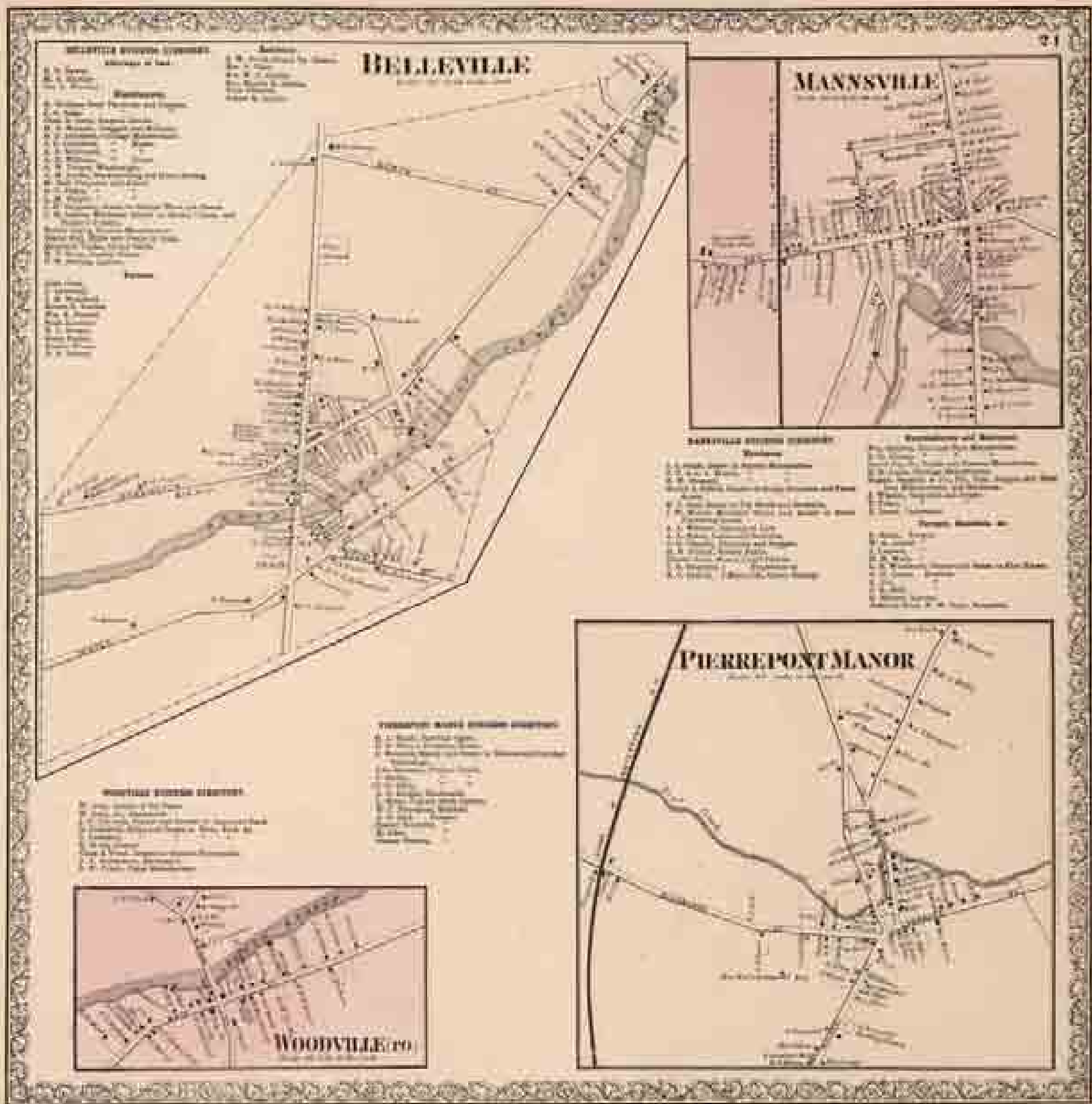

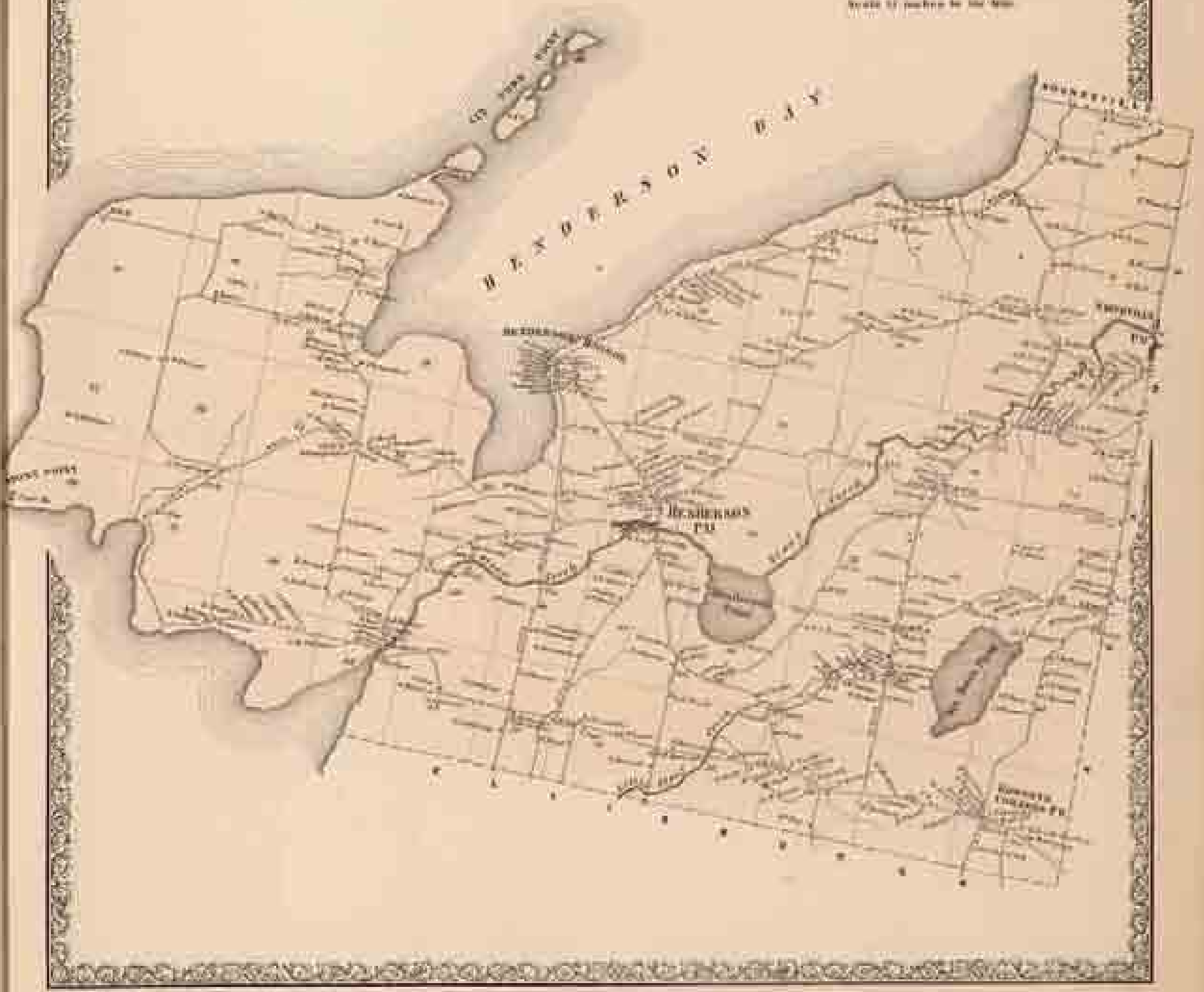

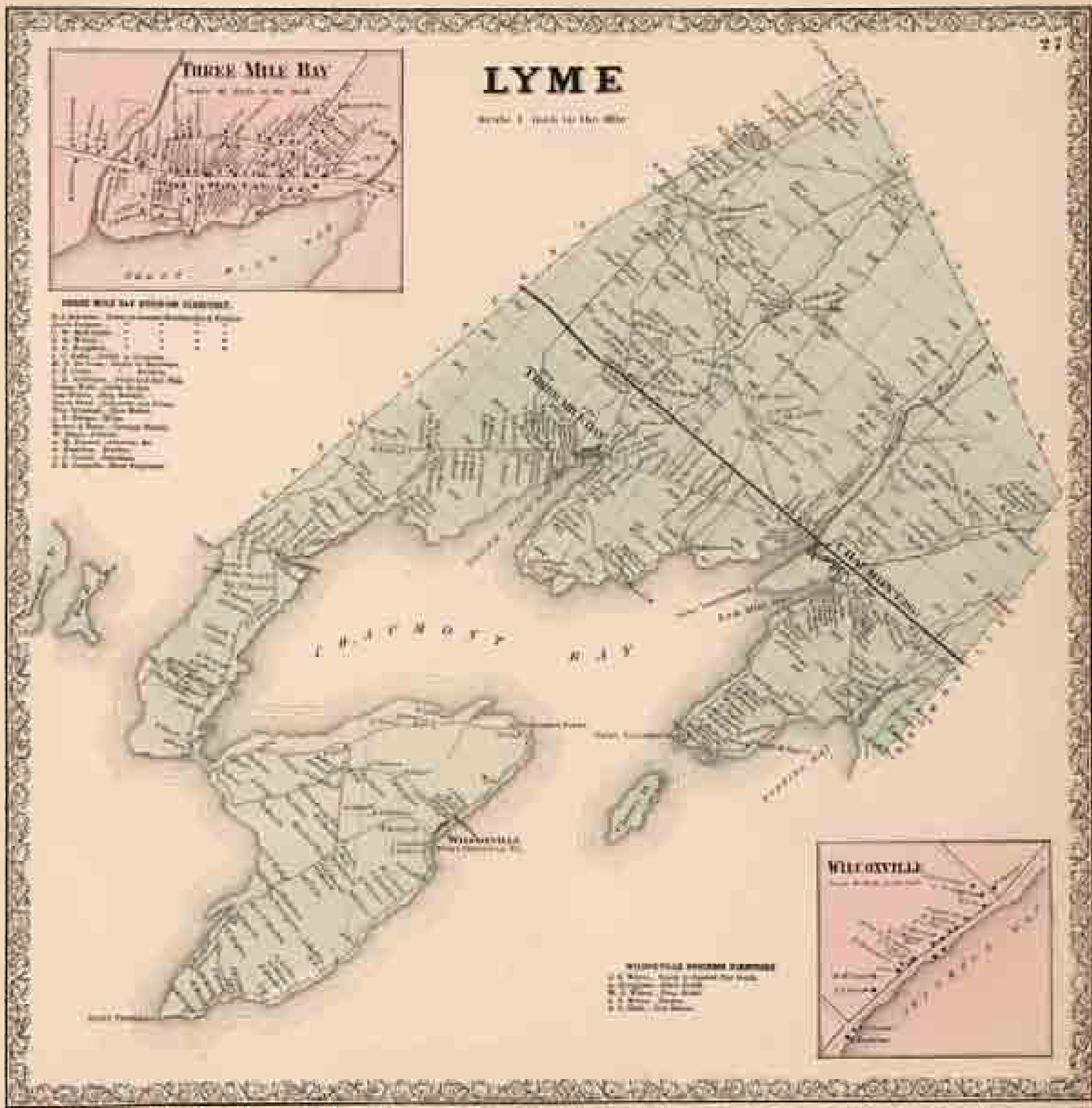

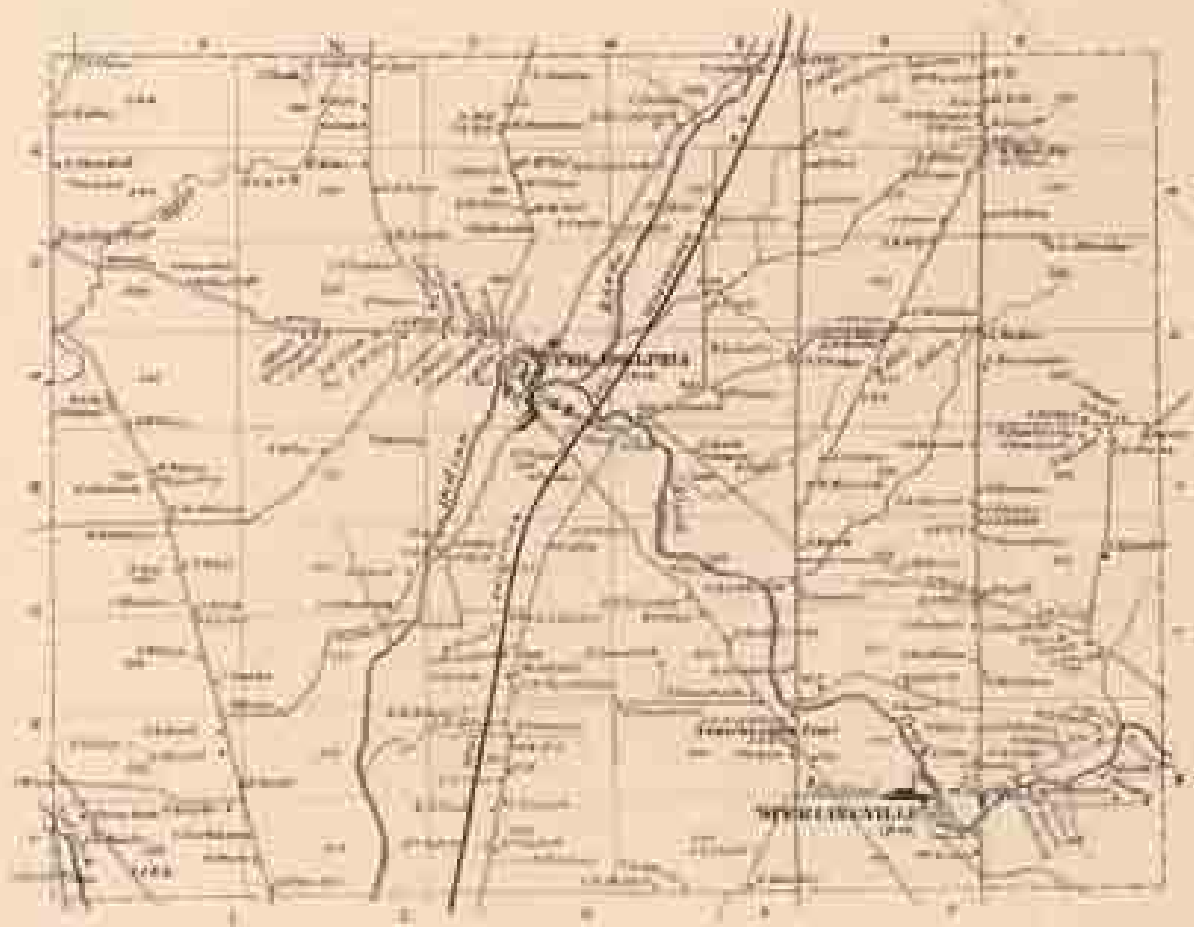

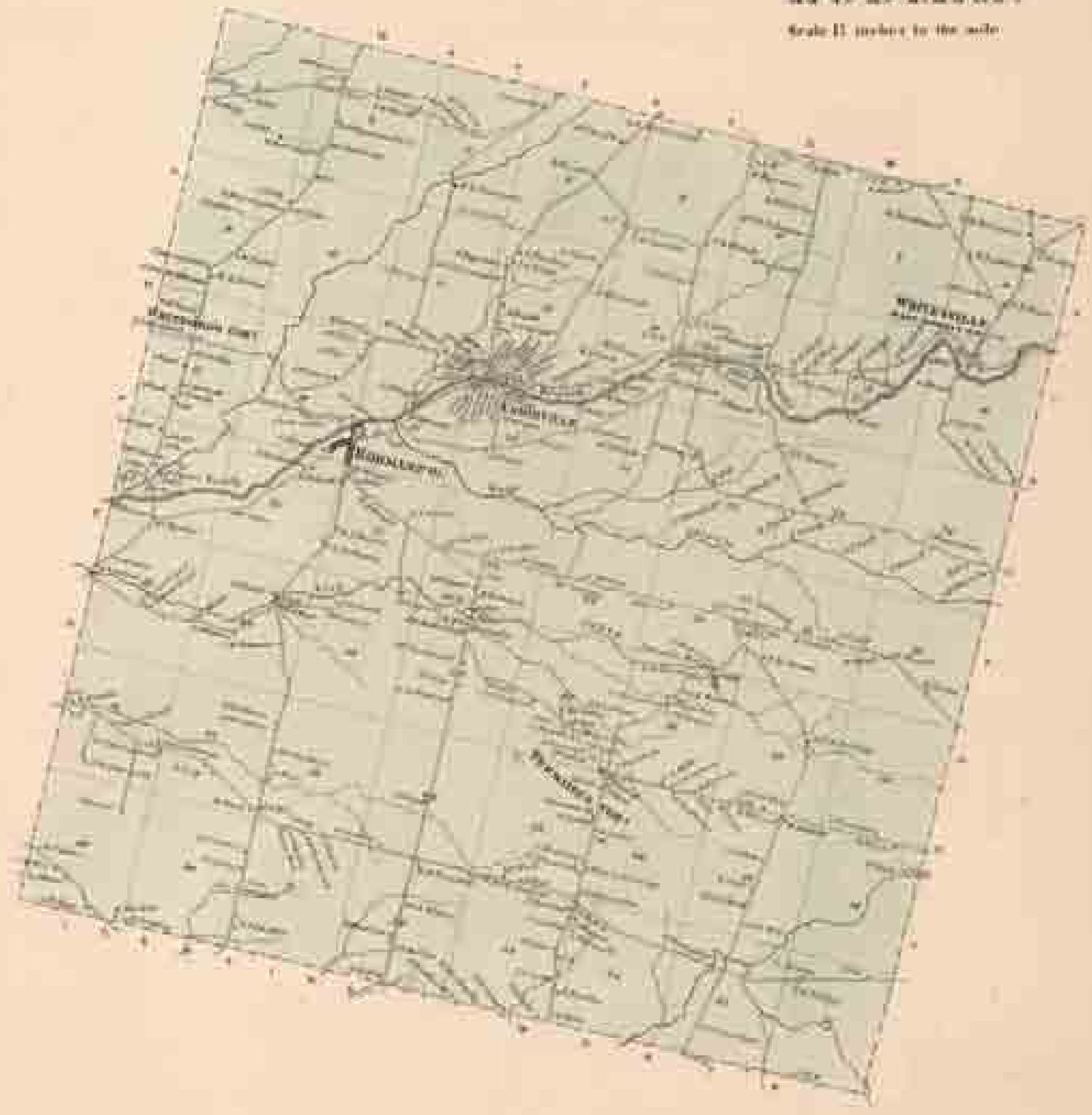

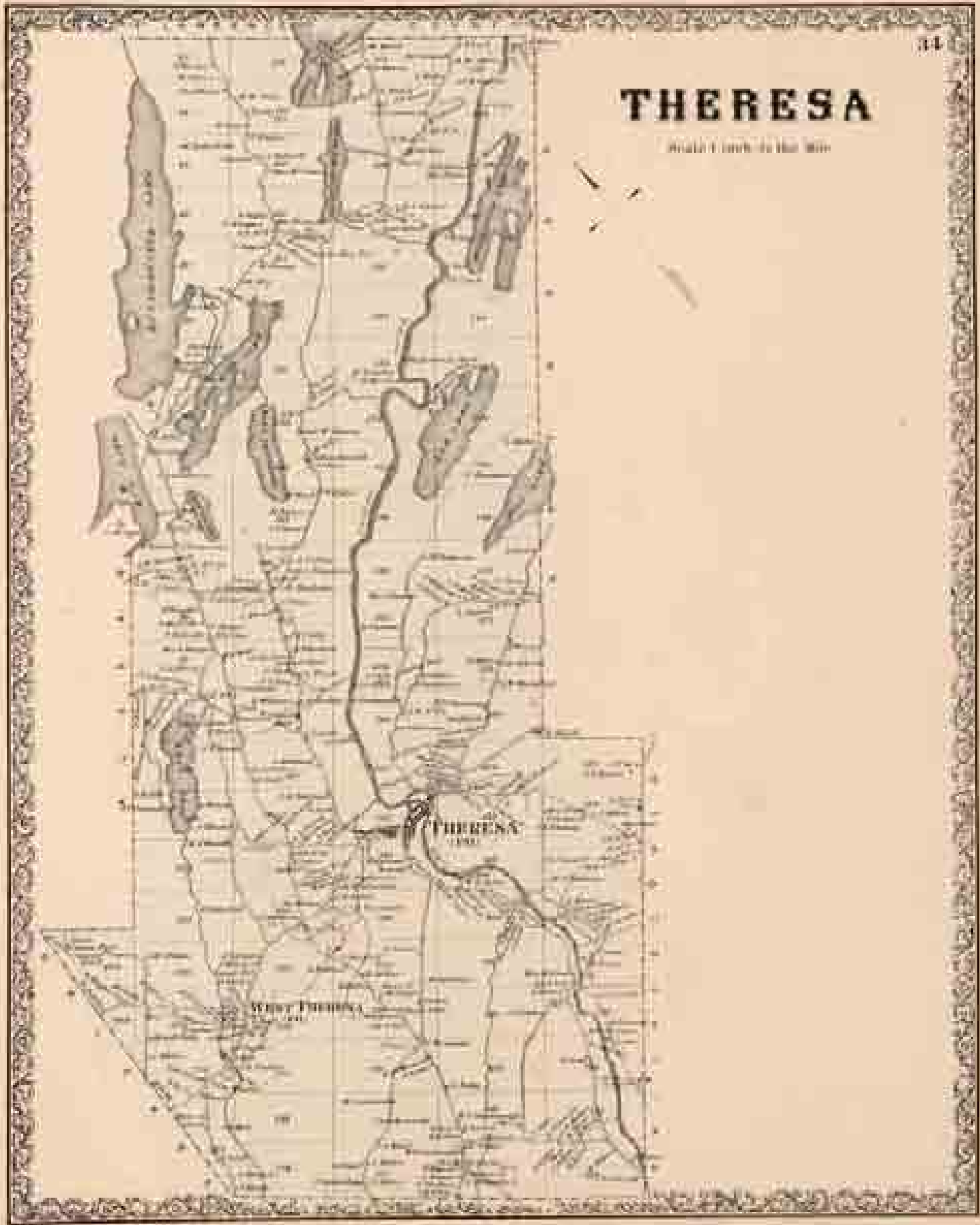

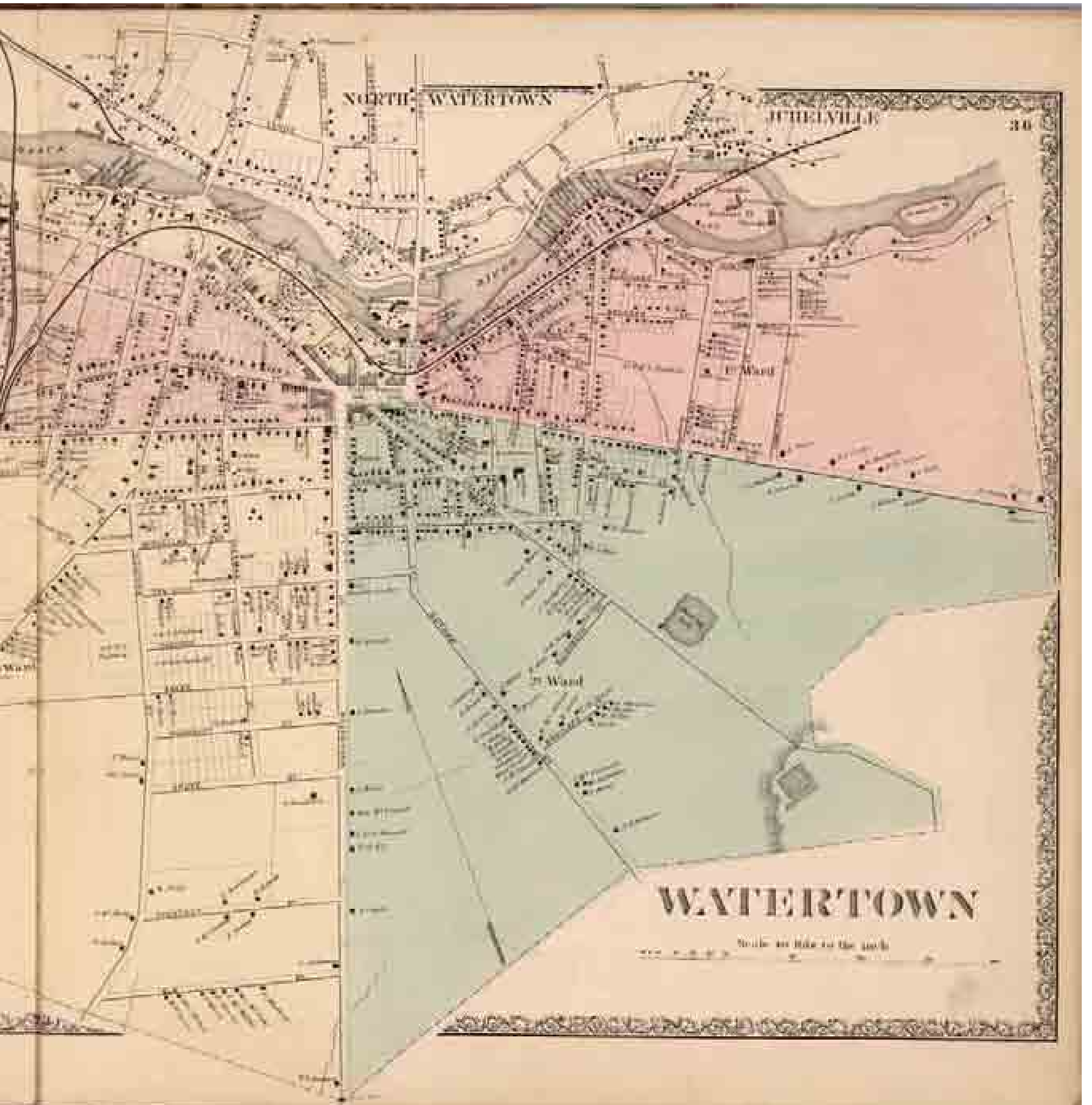

WATERWORKS SYSTEM

Waterworks system of North Waterbury, Vermont, showing the location of the waterworks, the water supply, and the distribution system. The water is drawn from the Lake Champlain and is pumped into a reservoir. From the reservoir, the water is distributed to the various parts of the town through a system of pipes and valves.

Water and Sewerage Plant, North Waterbury, Vermont

This plant is situated on the shore of Lake Champlain. It consists of a waterworks and a sewerage plant. The waterworks draws water from the lake and pumps it into a reservoir. The sewerage plant collects the sewage from the town and discharges it into the lake.

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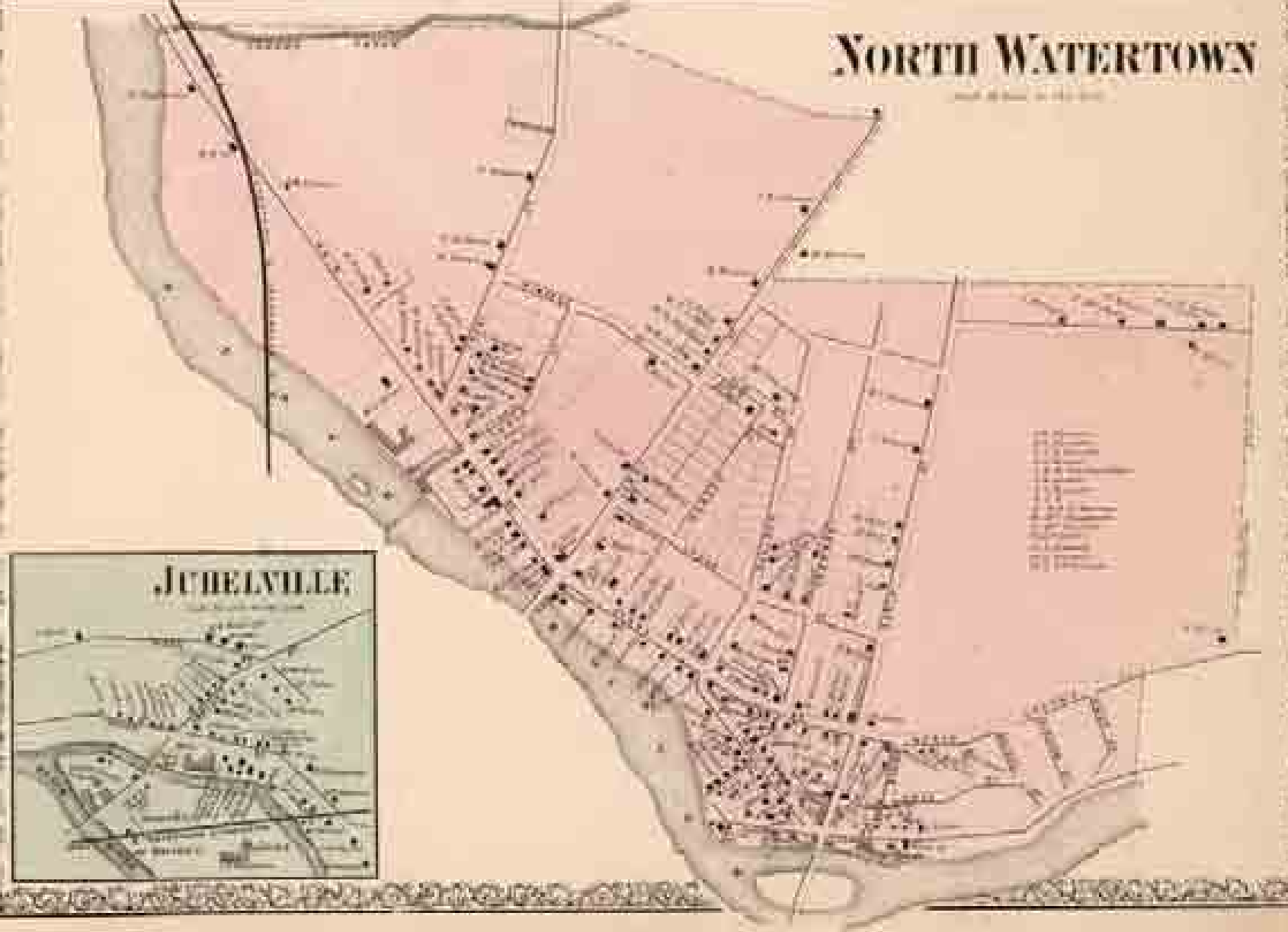
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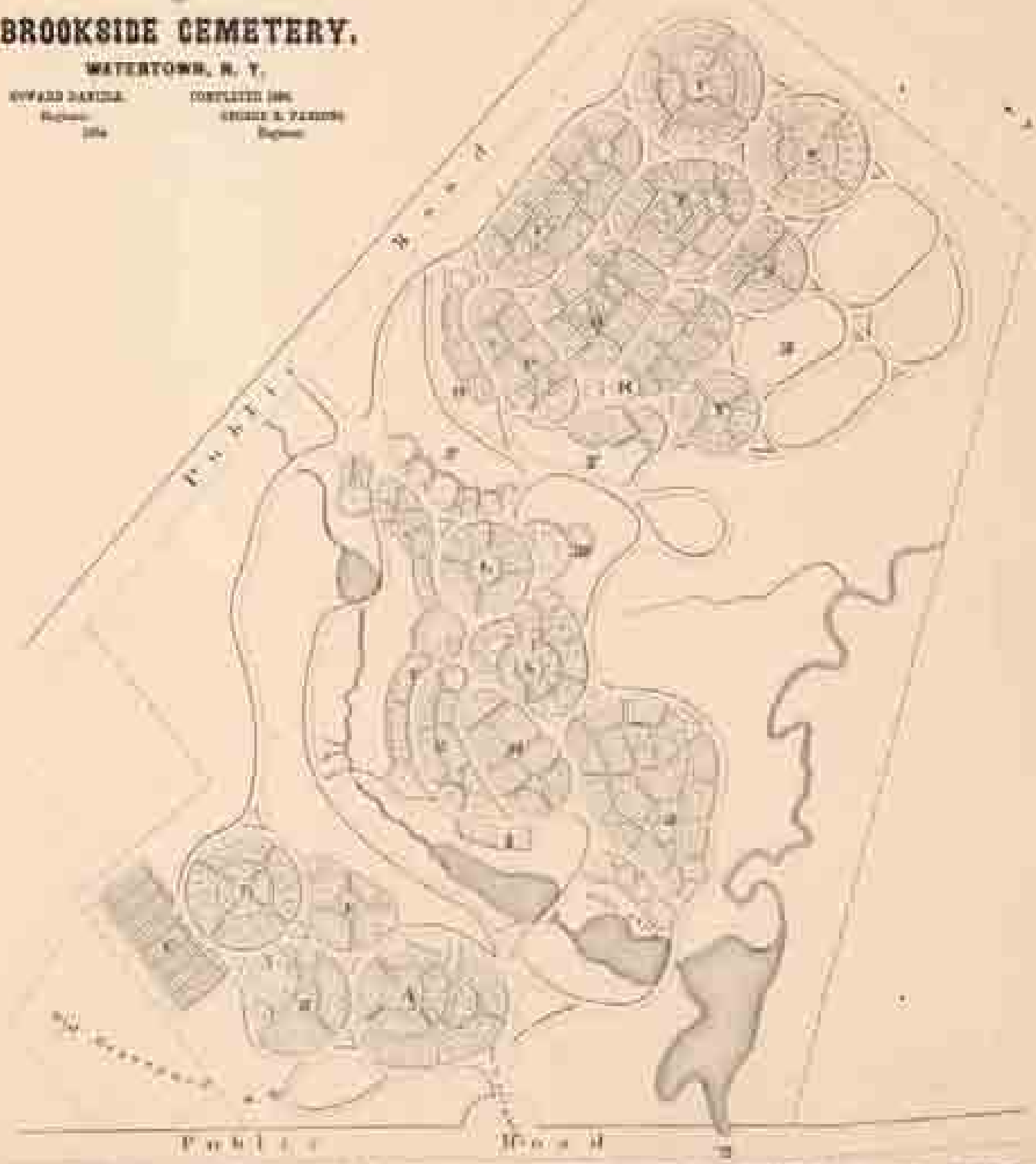


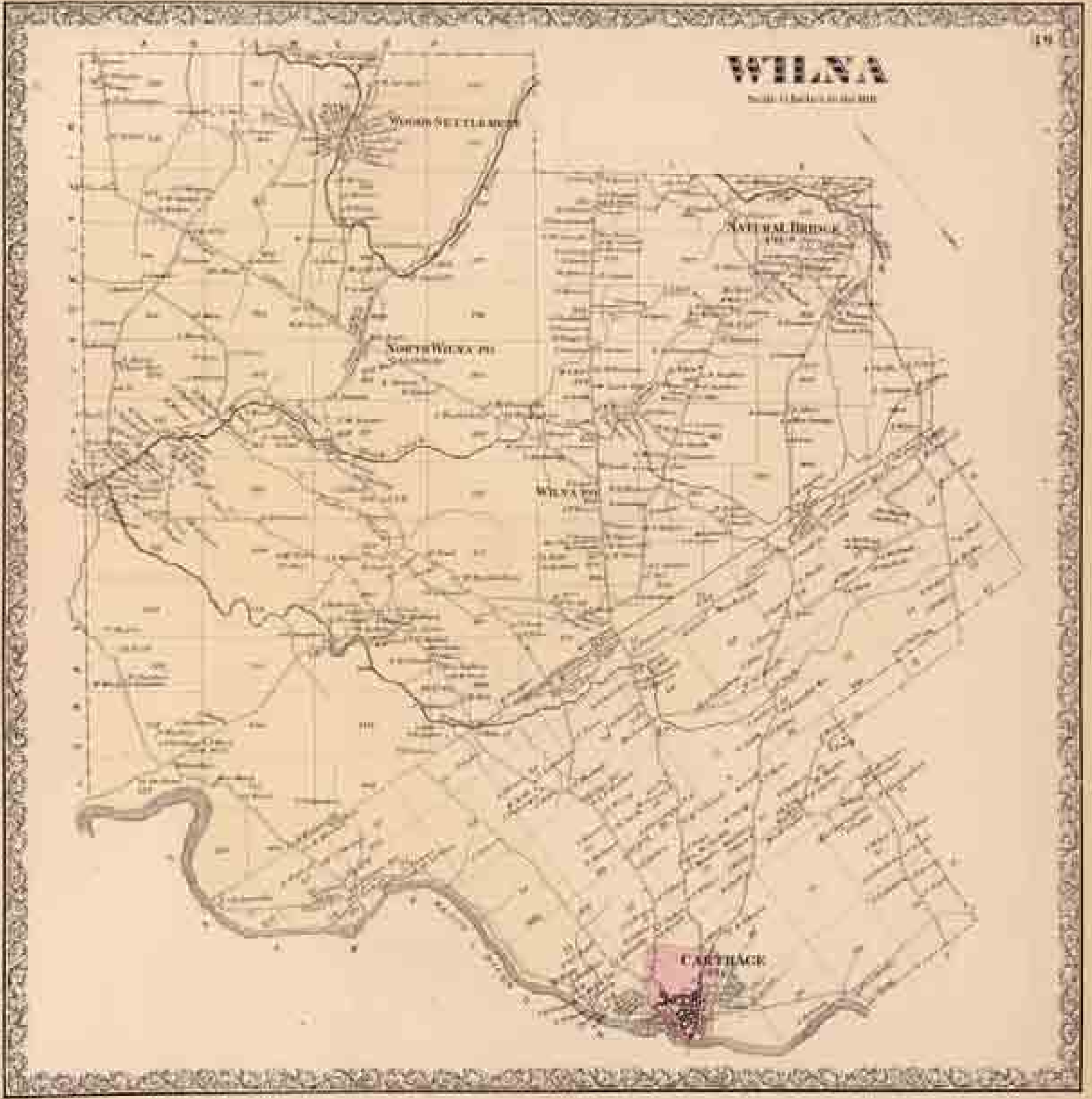
PLAN OF BROOKSIDE CEMETERY.

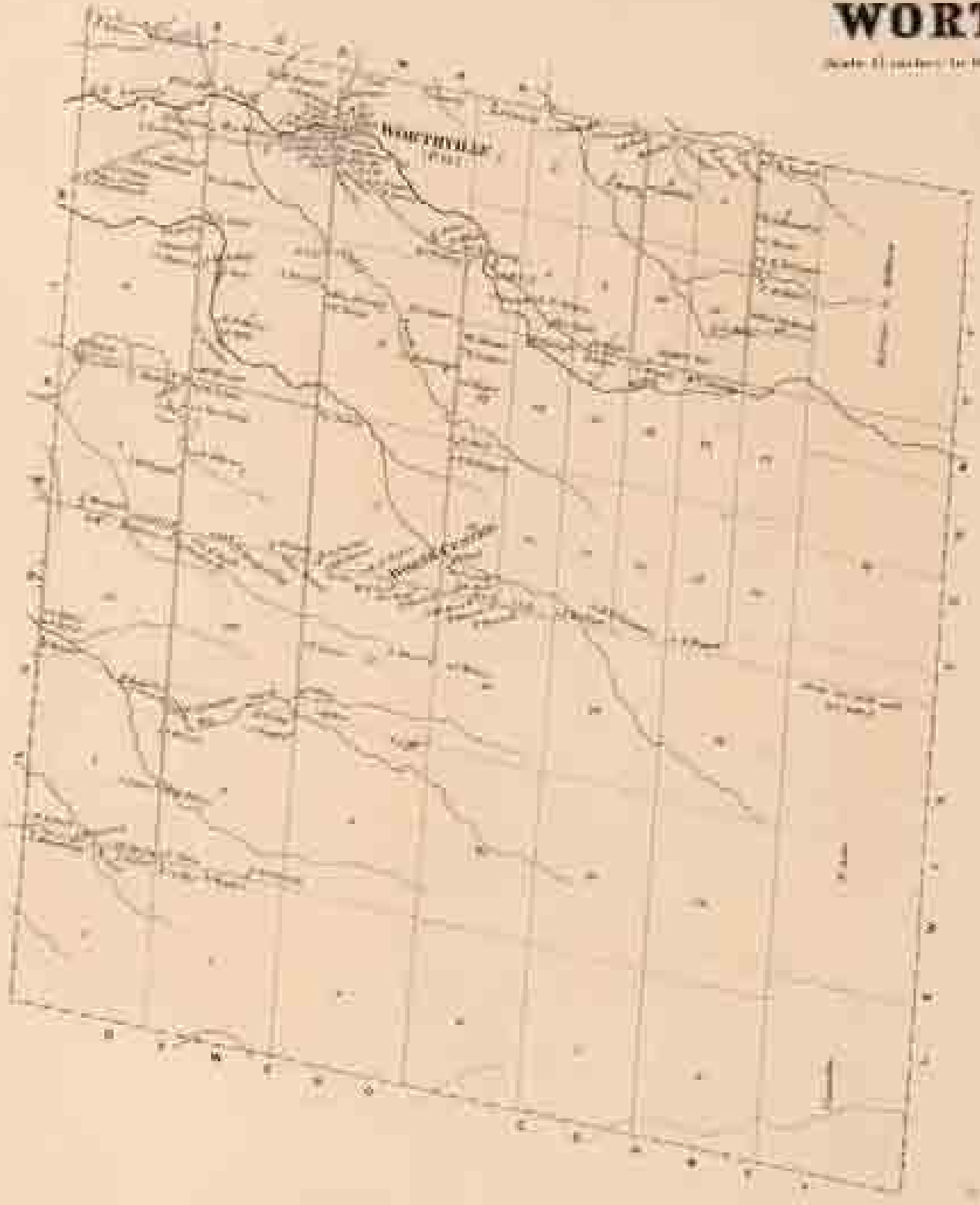

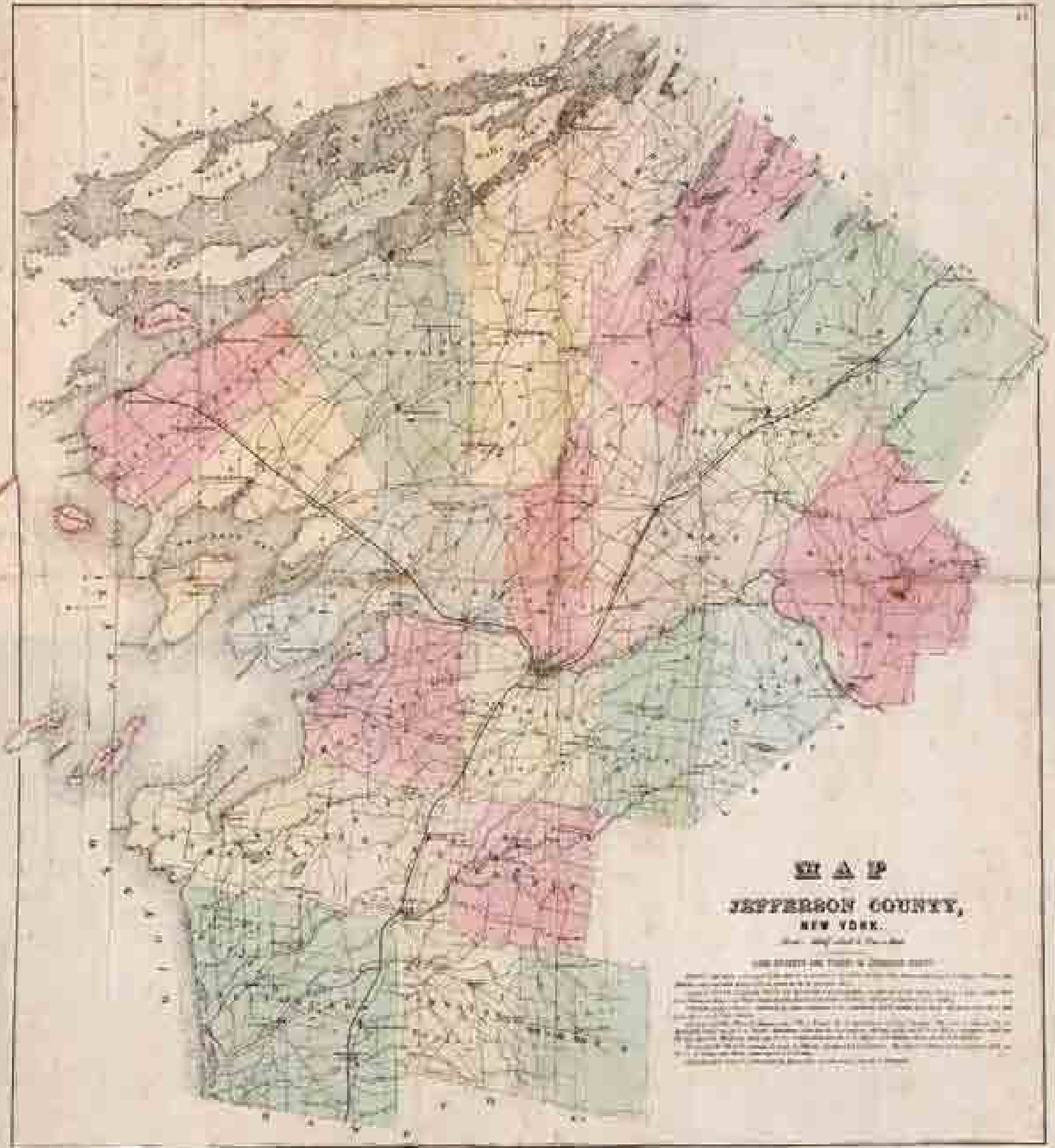
